According to the APPA Constitution, Article V, Section 9: To qualify for elected office in this association, the candidates must be:

(a) an active individual member in good standing, willing and able to fulfill the duties of the office for which nominated, and be willing and able to serve in the office for the length of time necessary to fulfill the duties of the office.

Regional directors are required to attend one Board of Directors meeting each year. These meetings occur during the Winter and Annual Training Institutes.

Nominations must be received by mail or email by March 31, 2018. Members are encouraged to nominate themselves for regional director positions. This position offers members an opportunity to present and discuss issues germane to the field and set the course for future initiatives for your association. The APPA Nominations Committee selects eligible candidates for each regional director position from those nominated and prepares the ballot. Candidates accepting a nomination for regional director must provide a biography or statement of fewer than 150 words, which will be included on the ballot. The schedule below will be followed for the 2018 election.

Timeline

February to March 31 - Call for Nominations for regional director positions.

March 31 - Cut-off date for nominations for regional director positions.

April 9 - Nominations Committee selects two candidates for each regional director position from those nominated and prepares ballot.

April 16 - Nominations Committee informs Executive Committee and Board of Directors of the slate.

May 16 - Ballots sent electronically via email to eligible voters or through USPS for voters with no email on record.

June 27 - Last day for electronic ballot receipt or postmark for mailed ballots.

July 2 - Ballots counted.

July 9 - All candidates notified of election results.

July 29 - Results reported to Board of Directors.
