

Offender Re-entry Programs: Housing Options for Successful Re-entry

Co-presented by Mr. Tony Fish, Director of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation's Reintegration Program and Mr. James Bender, the Senior Case Manager for the Muscogee (Creek) Nation's Reintegration Program, this webinar will examine the scope of re-entry housing options spanning from the early days of the program to today. The conversation will focus on successes, lessons learned, unique partnerships with housing vendors, and the motivation for constructing culturally appropriate housing units.

This is a unique opportunity to build on re-entry and dive into how housing options can have an impact for those on probation. Learning objectives for this webinar include:

- 1. Examining how housing is the foundation and starting point for successful re-entry;
- 2. Discussing various ways to create lifelong partnerships with housing vendors and discovering unique ways to engage them in the mission of successful re-entry;
- 3. Understanding how culturally appropriate transitional housing helps impact the outcomes for success.
